

**Norfolk County Council  
(Gillingham) (Emergency Notice)  
Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022  
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Anglian Water burst water main the use by vehicles of the U76303 Kings Dam from 310m west of its junction with Marsh Lane for 40m westwards in the PARISH OF GILLINGHAM will be temporarily prohibited from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> September 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: Kings Dam, Dunburgh Road, Gillingham Road, Geldeston Road, The Street (Geldeston, Gillingham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
