Meeting of the Parish Council

Minutes

Held in the side room of Wherry Inn

Monday 13th June 2022, 6 PM

Parish Councillors present: I. Ansell (chairman), J. Hayward, L. Rowntree and A. Wade.

Cllr J. Crowfoot arrived late.

Chairman's Welcome

- a. Apologies were recorded for Cllrs Ashfield and Shave.
- b. No other declarations were recorded.
- c. There were no members of the public in attendance

New issues

- a. Reports from the County Councillors and District Councillors – No District or County Councillors present.
- b. Parish 10 – No members of the public present.
- c. The quotes were discussed from Caloo, Playforce and Fresh Air Fitness suppliers. There was a discussion over the high costs of siting a Table Tennis Table on flat ground with a suitable playing surface, approximately £6000. It was decided to delay the table purchase until a more cost-effective solution could be found. The adult gym equipment from all three companies was compared with the feedback from the sub-committee on practical use, and it was agreed to appoint Caloo to supply and install (Prop: AW; Sec: LR) all agreed. The total of this project will be £9,747.34.

- d. To discuss the naming and logo of the project. The proposed logo was agreed. The Parish Council will have to buy £75 for the licence to use the logo. The play area and field is now called Geldeston Village Park. (Prop: AW; Sec: JC) All in agreement.
- e. To discuss the safety and access controls for the whole area before preparing a presentation to all parties. This was discussed in a closed session.
- f. Discuss and agree on any other outstanding issues relating to the project. The presentation will be a big event. It was considered appropriate to have the presentation before the next Parish Council meeting. Cllr Wade mentioned the need to check the play equipment's safety regularly. **Action Clerk** to organise some play inspection training.
- g. Cllr Crowfoot mentioned the issues whilst on a walk on his work along Stockton Road and across the fields back down Layden Lane. **Action Clerk** has requested information on this, to report.
